- Ask your child to talk to you about what they are good at and things that they find difficult.
- Ask your child to share their likes and dislikes with you.

Literacy

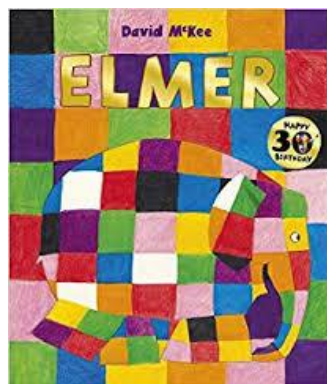
- Share lots of stories and other texts together and talk about the characters.
- When reading point to the words, highlighting that we always read from left to right.
- Practise reading and writing CVC words with your child.

Communication and Language

- Encourage your child to talk about their day in full sentences.
- Ask the children to retell some of their favourite stories.
- When sharing a story with your child ask them if they can tell you what might happen next.

Physical Development

- Encourage your child to dress themselves independently, including putting on their coat.
- Talk to your children about healthy eating and which types of food are healthy.
- Encourage your children to follow good hygiene routines such as hand washing and teeth brushing.

Maths

- Lots of counting, count everything especially when the children are playing.
- Help your child to recognise numbers to 10.
- Help your child to find shapes within your home environment.

Understanding the World/ Expressive Arts and Design

- Talk about animals that you see when you are out and how to care for them.
- Discuss the weather/ seasons changes.
- Talk about how people change as they grow older.
- Discuss different jobs.
- Sing songs together.
- Listen to music and explore the sounds of instruments.
